### Objective

The objective of the two Annual Glaucoma Research Awards offered by the Canadian Glaucoma Society (CGS) and Merck is to encourage Residents from a Canadian Ophthalmology program as well as Ophthalmologists practicing in Canada to undertake investigative research work in any area of glaucoma.

### Categories

The Annual Glaucoma Research Awards are composed of 2 individual categories:

1. Best Resident Glaucoma Research Proposal Award for proposed or ongoing research not yet completed.
2. Best Glaucoma Paper Award by a Resident or Canadian Ophthalmologist Research paper  
*Must be published in a peer reviewed journal in 2009.*

Note: Nominees can not submit in both categories in a given year

### Awards

The award for each category is:

- A grant of \$3,000; and
- Presentation of the Awards to the recipients at the:  
Canadian Glaucoma Society Meeting (COS Annual Meeting)  
Quebec City, Quebec  
June 26-29, 2010



# 2010 Annual Glaucoma Research Awards

### Eligibility

All Residents in ophthalmology registered in a Canadian University (Awards 1 and 2) and Ophthalmologists practicing in Canada (Award 2)

### Jury

The jury is composed of select members from the scientific committee of the Canadian Glaucoma Society.

### Topics

All topics related to glaucoma will be considered for both Award categories.

Judging criteria will be based on the following:

- Originality;
- Experimental design;
- Scientific rationale;
- Innovative approach;
- Soundness of conclusion (for category 2); and
- Suitability for publication
