

## **Glaucoma Specialist—University of Ottawa**

The Department of Ophthalmology at the University of Ottawa ([www.eyeinstitute.net](http://www.eyeinstitute.net)) invites applications for a full-time glaucoma specialist. The successful candidate would join 4 other glaucoma specialists in providing tertiary glaucoma care to Ottawa and Eastern Ontario (population 1.5 million).

Our well equipped facility includes HRT3, OCT3, OCT/SLO, anterior segment OCT, Pentacam, Pascal tonometry, a networked automated perimetry suite (HFA II-i), UBM, and multifocal ERG. In addition to standard SLT/ALT, trabeculectomy and tube procedures surgical modalities offered include endocyclophotocoagulation, and Trabectome.

Academic responsibilities include participation in resident teaching and clinical, basic science or educational research. The Ottawa Hospital and the University of Ottawa Eye Institute have recently completed an ambitious building program and tremendous opportunity exists to develop clinical and translational research programs in glaucoma. A state-of-the-art wet-lab facility and surgical simulator are conveniently located to facilitate the teaching of glaucoma surgical skills.

This opportunity is well suited to an experienced individual with a record of clinical/surgical proficiency and scholarship. However, exceptional candidates completing fellowship training are also encouraged to apply. Remuneration is fee-for-service with full surgical and laser privileges. An office at the University of Ottawa Eye Institute, The Ottawa Hospital will be provided as well as startup secretarial support. A stipend may be available to defray the costs of transitioning practice or to support dedicated research time.

The selected candidate will receive an academic appointment in the Department of Ophthalmology, University of Ottawa commensurate with qualifications and experience. The candidates must have completed a glaucoma fellowship and be licensed or eligible for licensure in Ontario.
