The Department of Ophthalmology and Visual Sciences at the University of British Columbia seeks an outstanding surgeon for a Clinical Faculty position in the Vitreo-Retinal Division. The successful candidate will hold a clinical appointment in the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority at Vancouver General Hospital and at Providence Health Care. The successful candidate must hold an FRCSC. They will have completed a minimum of two years of fellowship training. The candidate must have training in the diagnosis and treatment of medical and surgical vitreo-retinal diseases, the diagnosis and treatment of ocular oncology (including the medical work-up, surgical planning and administration of plaques and external beam irradiation, chemotherapy and use of biologics), diagnosis and treatment of uveitis. They will be expected to participate in undergraduate, resident, and fellow teaching. They will be expected to participate in the clinical research of the vitreo-retinal and ocular oncology divisions.

UBC hires on the basis of merit and is committed to employment equity. We encourage all qualified applicants to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents of Canada will be given priority.
